POLICY No. 218 PROGRAM

INTERNET SAFETY AND TECHNOLOGY: ACCEPTABLE AND RESPONSIBLE USE

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees of the Carson City School District ("District") that Information and Communications Technology ("ICT") shall be used solely for educational, instructional, District operations, and other purposes consistent with the mission of the District, including uses that further the educational objectives of the District.

Use of District ICT shall be in alignment with the District's Strategic Plan, shall comply with applicable provisions of state and federal laws and regulations, and shall not be used to transmit information in violation of any applicable law or regulation. Use of District ICT which is bullying, obscene, or disruptive to the educational processes of the District shall not be allowed.

This Policy and any implementing regulations are intended to comply with applicable state or federal law, and in the event of any conflict or inconsistency therewith, the provisions of applicable state or federal law shall control.

As used in this Policy and any implementing regulations, the term Information and Communications Technology includes any devices, networks, software, systems, services, XaaS (the delivery of anything as a service, typically over the Internet), and other technology that enable interaction with digital data, systems, and services.
