CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION

The Board of Trustees acknowledges that having personnel trained in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is an important part of the District's Safety and Emergency Operation Plans. The Superintendent or designee will establish a plan for providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation instruction for District employees. The CPR plan will identify courses of study and activities that are considered a high risk for students. In addition, the plan must contain a method for tracking personnel who teach or supervise these courses or activities and for the certification of persons in the administration of CPR in a manner that complies with the guidelines established by the American National Red Cross and/or the American Heart Association. The plan shall meet the requirements of NRS 391.092, shall be submitted to the Board for approval, and then be submitted to the State Board of Education.

The plan shall make clear that the District will provide the resources necessary for training, including certified instructors and written material, and shall set forth an estimate of the time required for the training, currently four (4) hours.
