CCSD began the RFP process in January 2018, once the RFP process was completed the team reviewed the submitted A.P. Biology Science textbooks. Based on the rubric scoring the committee determined that publisher presentations were not necessary. By following the rubric scoring system, the committee selected Mader, Biology 2019, 13e AP published by McGraw Hill.
