CCSD began the RFP process in January 2018, once the RFP process was completed the team reviewed the submitted A.P. Physics Science textbooks. Based on the rubric scoring led by A.P. Physics teacher James Bean, the committee determined that publisher presentations were not necessary and selected Serway & Vuille, *College Physics* 2018, 11e AP published by Cengage Learning Inc.
