CCSD began the RFP process in October 2018. Once the RFP process was completed, the textbook adoption committee reviewed all the publishers that submitted. Based on the initial rubric scoring, the committee determined that publisher presentations were necessary and invited three publishers to present their textbooks and online platforms. Three 2-hours sessions were scheduled and all the committee members attended. After another round of rubric scoring, the committee determined that Houghton Mifflin Harcourt and its product Bien Dit! best aligned with the NVACS, along with supporting the curriculum and assessments that have been developed by the French teachers at Carson High School. The committee overwhelmingly agreed that Bien Dit! will support students to be successful.
