BYLAW No. R-020 AUTHORITY OF POWERS

## **DELEGATION OF RESPONSIBILITIES**

In the delegation of certain executive powers to the Superintendent of Schools, the Board may authorize the Superintendent or his/her designee to establish various committees for educational purposes.

These committees may be comprised of administrators, teachers, students, and/or members of the general public, as needed. All such committees are advisory, only. In those cases where the responsible administrator requests that a vote be taken, the vote is for the sole purpose establishing the consensus of the committee. Final decision-making authority will reside with the Board of School Trustees.

At the first meeting of each committee, the responsible administrator will provide a written statement outlining the objectives and responsibilities of the committee.
