POLICY No. 221 PROGRAM

## RESOURCE MATERIALS

The Board shall provide instructional and resource materials, within budgetary constraints, to implement the District and school educational goals and objectives and meet pupil needs.

The Superintendent shall be responsible for the selection and maintenance of resource materials; shall appoint appropriate administrative and instructional staff to select resource materials; and shall insure an inventory of resource materials that is well-balanced and well-rounded in coverage of subject, types of materials, and variety of content.

Supplementary printed materials from commercial, political, religious or other non-school sources must be approved by the Superintendent before being used in the schools. Such approval may be given to those non-school materials, which are of obvious educational quality, which supplement and enrich text and reference book materials for definite school course, which are timely and up-to-date and which promote democratic ideals and moral values.

Teachers may use non-printed materials from non-school sources, such as models, cuts, video/DVD, internet, slides, pictures, charts and exhibits for educational purposes with the approval of the principal, although such materials may bear the name of a commercial business firm which may have provided the aid.
