Children who are not fully prepared for kindergarten may struggle to keep up with their peers, which can lead to frustration, low self-esteem, and a dislike of school.

By making sure that your child is kindergarten ready, you are giving them the best possible start to their educational journey. This means that they are more likely to be engaged and motivated learners. It is important that parents take an active role in their child's early learning and work with them to help them acquire the skills they need to succeed in Kindergarten and beyond!
